

USERS

The Realtime Register system supports individual users for your account. Users can be persons or systems integrating with our API's within your own organization who are permitted to login and, view, create, update or remove items in your account.

For example: if you want to limit the access for a person within your organization to only financial related transactions and no domain name related operations.

USER ROLES

A user role is a set of permissions that can be associated to one or more users. You can consider a user role as a template for permissions. A user can have one or more roles. In general you do not create a role for person but for a function.

PERMISSIONS

Below you will find the permissions and their descriptions. By default the user "admin" has all permissions available in the account, the user "admin" must always retain the "MANAGE_USERS" and "USER_PASSWORD_RESET" permissions to avoid a lock out.

ACK_NOTIFICATION

Allows the user to actively acknowledge a notification

ACTIVATE_USER

Allows the user to activate a user.

ADD_EVIDENCE_INFORMATION

Allows the user to upload identity evidence information for a contact handle. For example to order an SSL certificate.

CANCEL_TRANSFER_DOMAIN

Allows the user to cancel domain transfers.

CHANGE_CUSTOMER_NOTIFICATION_RULE

Allows the user to change the ways notifications are send from the Realtime Register systems.

CHANGE_CUSTOMER_NOTIFICATION_SCHEDULE

Allows the user to change the schedule of messages are being send from the Realtime Register system.

CHECK_DOMAIN

Allows the user to check if a domain name is available at the particular registry.

CREATE_CONTACT

Allows the user to create a contact in the Realtime Register system.

CREATE_DOMAIN

Allows the user to create a domain.

CREATE_HOST

Allows the user to create a host object.

CREATE_SSL_CERTIFICATE

Allows the user to initiate the application for a SSL certificate.

DEACTIVATE_USER

Allows a user with the permission MANAGE_USERS, to deactivate a user.

DELETE_CONTACT

Allows the user to delete a contact.

DELETE_DOMAIN

Allows the user to delete a domain.

DELETE_HOST

Allows the user to delete a host object.

DEPOSIT

Allows the user to initiate a deposit.

MANAGE_USERS

Allows the user to manager users.

RENEW_DOMAIN

Allows the user to renew a domain.

RENEW_SSL_CERTIFICATE

Allows the user to initiate the renewal of a certificate.

RESTORE_DOMAIN

Allows the user to initiate a restore.

SPLIT_CONTACT

Allows the user to split a contact in order to update a one or more TLD's.

TRANSFER_DOMAIN

Allows the user to transfer a domain name to the customer's account.

UPDATE_CONTACT

Allows the user to update contact handles.

UPDATE_CUSTOMER_PROFILE

Allows the user to update the customer profile.

UPDATE_DNS

Allows the user to update DNS templates.

UPDATE_DOMAIN

Allows the user to update domain names.

UPDATE_HOST

Allows the user to update host objects.

USER_PASSWORD_RESET

Allows a user with the permission **MANAGE_USERS** to initiate the password reset procedure, if a user does not have this permission password resets must be done by a user with the **MANAGE_USERS** permission.

VIEW_BILLING

Allows the user to view invoices, financial transactions and prices that are set for the account.

VIEW_CONTACT

Allows the user to view contact handle information.

VIEW_DNS

Allows the user to view the DNS template details.

VIEW_DOMAIN

Allows the user to view the domain name details.

VIEW_EVIDENCE_INFORMATION

Allows the user If uploaded documents are present for a contact handle, to view the uploaded documentation.

VIEW_HOST

Allows the user to view the Host objects details.

VIEW_NOTIFICATION

Allows the user to view notifications.

VIEW_PROCESS

Allows the user to view the details of a process, for example; its status and history. Typical processes are domain create, update, contact create, update.

VIEW_SSL_CERTIFICATE

Allows the user to view if there are SSL certificates are present in the account.

VIEW_TRANSFER_DOMAIN

Allows the user to view if there are transfers are present in the account.
